mercy shall be theirs.

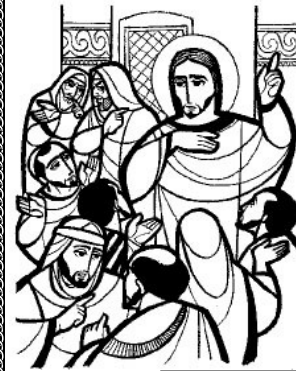
Blest are they, the pure of heart,
